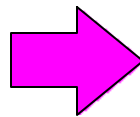

Some Examples of Hazardous Wastes Accepted

Antifreeze, Contaminated Oil, Fluorescent Lamps, Freon/Refrigerants, Elemental Mercury, Mercury Containing Devices, Spent Solvents, PCB's, Oil-Based Paints and Thinners, Photochemical Wastes, Pesticides, Heavy Metal Wastes

Wastes Not Accepted

Latex Paint, Gas Cylinders, Radioactive Material, Empty Containers from Hazardous Products, Explosives (including Fireworks), Ammunition, Asbestos
