Some Examples of Hazardous Wastes Accepted

Antifreeze, Contaminated Oil, Fluorescent
Lamps, Freon/Refrigerants, Elemental Mercury,
Mercury Containing Devices, Oil-Based
Paints and Thinners, Photochemicals &
Silver-Bearing Dark Room Waste, Pesticides

Materials Not Accepted

Latex Paint, Asbestos, Gas Cylinders, Radioac-
tive Material, Empty Containers from Hazardous
Products, Explosives (including Fireworks),
Ammunition
